



Correctional Officer I Test Schedule

You must have a high school diploma or GED and be 21 years of age for appointment as a Correctional Officer I. Arrive for the walk-in session no later than 8:30 A.M. (except the evening date, if any) with a photo ID. Allow up to 5 hours for testing.

The Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS) announces the current schedule of open testing for Correctional Officer I. Correctional Officer I is the entry level of work involving the custody, security, and supervision of adult inmates in a correctional facility. These positions are located throughout the State. If you think you have what it takes to work in this exciting and rewarding field of criminal justice, we encourage you to attend one of the sessions listed below to take the VIDEO & WRITTEN exams, which is the first step in the hiring process.

- **Walk-in tests are given on a first-come, first-served basis (seats are limited); testing is not guaranteed after the allotted amount of seats are filled.**
- **If you are a veteran, please bring a copy of your DD-214.**
- **You may test only one time within a 12-month period and your initial score will be valid for one year. If you attempt to re-take the test while on the current eligible list, that exam will not be scored.**
- **For the walk-in testing, you do not need to complete an application prior to the exam.**

Minimum Qualifications: 21 years of age AND possess a High School diploma or GED certificate acceptable to the Maryland State Board of Education as described in the Maryland Police & Correctional Training Commission (MPCTC) regulations.

The above minimum qualifications will be verified prior to selection.

PLEASE KEEP IN MIND:

- Applicants must meet the selection standards required and successfully complete the training prescribed by the MPCTC; to be eligible for the training, candidates must:
 - provide evidence of being a **U.S. Citizen** or **Resident Alien**
 - successfully complete both a **background investigation** and a **physical examination**
 - successfully undergo a **psychological evaluation**
- Once hired, Correctional Officers will be subject to:
 - being **on-call 24 hours a day** and therefore must have a telephone at their place of residence
 - **substance abuse testing**
- Once hired, Correctional Officers may be:
 - assigned duties that require the operation of a motor vehicle; employees assigned these duties will be required to **possess a motor vehicle operator's license** valid in the State of Maryland.
 - required to operate large vans for transportation of inmates; employees assigned these duties will be required to acquire a Class C Maryland driver's license.

SELECTION PROCESS: Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications and successfully complete the test will be placed on the employment eligible list categorized as Best Qualified, Better Qualified or Qualified. The list will be used by the DPSCS to select employees for at least one year.
